Background and Summary: The Georgia Department of Transportation is improving the interchange at I-285, 75 and Frontage Road. The Frontage Road improvement will include 36 new street lights within the City at an annual energy cost of approximately \$4,800.

The purpose of this agenda item is for the Mayor and Council to formerly approve the Georgia Department of Transportation, Local Government Lighting Project Agreement (LGLPA). The Department of Transportation will be responsible for the design, installation, and all material cost. Georgia Power will manage the maintenance and operation. The City will be responsible for the energy cost.


